

For our 1and1.com customers these are your incoming and outgoing server settings;

Incoming server (POP) pop.1and1.com
Outgoing server (SMTP) smtp.1and1.com

Please note: Optionally, port 587 can also be used in addition to the default port (25) RFC 2476.

Outlook

Open Outlook

Go to tools> email accounts> add new email > next>

Choose POP3> Next

Your name: what ever name you wish to have displayed on your outgoing email

Type in your email address

User name: same as email address

Password: is your password

Next if there is an option for it, choose to manually set up

Incoming Mail server Pop3: pop.1and1.com

Outgoing Mail server smtp: smtp.1and1.com

Then click on more settings > out going server tab > check that first box and choose ok (server requires authentication)

Test that you can send **and** receive, if you cannot please go back into your email settings and go to more settings and choose the advanced tab and set outgoing smtp to port 587 and then test again.

Outlook express

Open Outlook express

File> identities>add new identity > next choose Yes

Display name is what ever you want recipients to see in your email header

Email: Type in your email address

Mail server is: 1and1.com

Pop3: pop.1and1.com

Smtp: smtp.1and1.com

Account name: Is your email address

Password: your password

Don't check the box, just hit next ... Then go back in to account settings go to properties, then click out going server tab, check the box server requires authentication and your done

Test that you can send **and** receive, if you cannot please go back into your email settings set outgoing smtp to port 587 and then test again.
